Aloha e nā 'Ohana:

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) provides parent(s)/guardian(s) of a HIBOE haumāna, the right to know the professional qualifications of their keiki's classroom kumu and if the haumāna is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so their qualifications. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your keiki's classroom kumu and paraprofessional(s) and requires us to give you this information in a timely manner upon request.

You have the right to ask for the following information about each of your keiki's classroom kumu.

1. Whether the kumu has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which he/she provides instruction.
2. Whether the kumu is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.
3. Whether the kumu is teaching in the field of discipline of their teacher certification.
4. Whether any kumu' aides or similar paraprofessionals provide services to your keiki and, if they do, their qualifications.
