Minimum Qualifications

- Education equivalent to ninth grade
- Experience of undertaking general cleaning duties
- Ability to understand and carry out verbal and written instruction
- Ability to manage time effectively and prioritize work
- Ability to work independently
- Use of a car or self transportation between campuses

Supervision

Member of the Operational team, under the immediate supervision of the Director of Operations & Human Resources Manager

Essential Functions

- Ensures that classrooms are swept, mopped, and/or vacuumed
- Empty waste baskets and replace trash liners
- Cleans sinks (if applicable)
- Clean whiteboards (blackboards) and rails
- Empty pencil sharpeners
- Ensures that desks and chairs are neatly arranged to ensure safety of students
- Follows all safety standards and training guidelines throughout the performance of duty
- Cares for custodial equipment
- Maintains a running inventory of maintenance supplies and places orders with supervisor, if needed
- Perform other related duties as assigned

Working Conditions: Indoors & outdoor classrooms

Hours: 2:30pm – 7:45pm, Monday-Friday (when school is in session)

Equipment Use: General maintenance/cleaning equipment- vacuum, broom/dustpan, mop, etc.

Physical, Mental and Communication Demands:
