He lā'au haka, 8ft x 8ft ka nui kēia, i kūkulu ai mai ka waiho ana i nā pōhaku ma ke kinona haka. Ua 'oki i ke kumu lā'au waiwī a kau i nā lā'au i loko o nā pōhaku. This is a huge 8ftx8ft heart. We made this by placing rocks on the ground in a shape of a heart. We cut waiwī from our forest and placed them within the rocks. We laid more pieces across the top and tied them together using jute. Then we flipped it over and we spray painted some of them white.
