# Makahiki

Me ka 'ūpoho 'ūpoho pa'i i mālama 'ia ai ka pana a helu 'ia nā 'ai a Lono. Ma kēlā me kēia hea 'ana ka'i aku kekahi 'elele papa e hā'awi aku ai i kā lākou ho'okupu. Ua ka'i ka 'aha a ua noa nā pā'ani makahiki.

'O ka 'ulu maika 'oe, 'o ka moa pahe'e 'oe, o ka hukihuki 'oe, 'o ke kūkini 'oe a nui hou aku nā pā'ani i pā'ani 'ia. Ua 'ākoakoa ko Ka 'Umeke Kā'eo, Ke Ana La'ahana a me ko Hi'iikeakaikamālama ma ka pā mau'u o Pā Hoaka. 'Ike a lohe koke 'ia ka ho'olaule'a 'ana i ia wā. 



# *Lā Kū'oko'a*



E o'u mau hoa maka'āinana, he aupuni kū'oko'a ko kākou i na'i 'ia e nā Kamehameha i moe akula, a 'o ka pono kūkulu aupuni kū'oko'a a lākou i 'imi ai, 'o ia kā kākou e hau'oli nei i kēia lā, no laila, he aha nā pilikia i ulu a'e i ko kākou noho kū'oko'a 'ana?

'O ke kū'oko'a a nā mākua Ali'i i 'imi ai i pono ho'oilina no ka lāhui, 'o ia ke ake 'ia nei e kanu ola 'ia, a'u e 'ōlelo a'e ai inā e ho'ohui 'ia kākou me 'Amelika, 'o ia ko kākou 'ae 'ana aku e kanu ola 'ia kākou ka lāhui i loko o nā pōpilikia he nui e hō'ea mai ana ma hope o ka ho'ohui 'ia 'ana.



## Welo Mau



Ua kā‘ili ‘ia ka hae a Mō‘ī Wahine Lili‘uokalani e Colonel John Harris Soper ka luna o ke Aupuni Kūikawā i ka wā i ho‘okahuli ‘ia ke aupuni Hawai‘i. ‘O ka lā 22 o Ianuali makahiki 1893 ka welo hope ‘ana o ia hae a ka Mō‘ī Wahine. Ma hope o ke kā‘ili ‘ia, ‘a‘ole i ‘ike ‘ia a i ‘Okakopa makahiki 2022 ma kekahī puke kūkālā ma ka Bonham’s Auction House. Ua ho‘opakele koke ‘ia kēia hae a me kekahī mau palapala ko‘iko‘i mai ke kūkālā ‘ia. Ua ho‘iho‘i ‘ia kēia hae aloha i Washington Place kahi i noho ai ‘o Mō‘ī Wahine Lili‘uokalani ma ka lā 24 o lulai makahiki 2023. He 130 mau makahiki o ka noho hemahema ‘ana o kēia hae.
