Aloha nui e ka makamaka heluhelu, ka po'e nāna e ho'olu'u nei i ka mō'aukala o ko'u ola. Ua hānai 'ia nō wau e ka 'ao'ao o ko ko'u makua kāne 'ohana ma Hilo Palikū, Kalaoa Mauka, Ale'amai, Onomea, me Kahali'i. 'O ia nō nā inoa 'āina o ko'u 'ohana. Noho papa ko'u 'ohana ma ia mau wahi nei no 'ewalu hanauna a hiki i nēia wā. He kua'āina mākou: 'o ka lawai'a 'oe, 'o ka mahi'ai 'oe, loa'a maila ka 'oihana i loko o ka 'ohana. Ia'u i huli makahiki ai he 'umikūmāmawalu, 'o ka ha'alele akula nō ia o'u mai ia wahi a kau ka mokulele no ka mea, kāhea maila 'o O'ahu-a-Lua, kahi i noho ai ko'u 'anakē, ka wahine nāna i hānai pū mai ia'u me ko'u makuahine. I laila nō wau i hele ai i ke kula 'ako lauoho ma 'Aiea. A puka akula mai ia kula nei, ho'omaka wau e hana ma Paul Brown Salon Kaka'ako.

'A'ole nō i li'uli'u, ma hope o 'elima makahiki, ho'i wau i Kalaoa Mauka i mea e huli ai ka lima i lalo me ka 'ohana. Ma ia wā ho'okahi, ua ho'oholo wau e 'imi i kahi hālau hula i hiki ia'u ke a'o mai. A laila 'imi akula a loa'a mai he hālau me 'Anakala Johnny mā. Noho wau ma laila no ho'okahi makahiki. Huli na'e ko'u wa'a 'imi na'auao iā Hālau o Kekuhi 'oiai wau i ho'omaka 'ē ai i ke Kula Kaiāulu o Hawai'i ma Hilo me Kekuhi lāua 'o Tangarō ma kahi o ke kauwela 2000. A no ko'u kama'āina iā lāua, paipai nui 'ia wau e komo i ka hālau e o'u mau hoa. I ka hemo 'ana mai o ka 'īpuka o kahi papa hula, 'o ka miki akula nō ia o'u i ke komo.

Ma ka makahiki 2006, ua kono 'ia wau e ka'u kumu hula 'o Tangarō e komo i kekahi papa 'ūniki ma lalo ona. 'Ae pū 'ia ko'u holo mua me ka'u kēkelē, 'oia ka 'ōlelo ho'opa'a a ia nei. 'O ka makahiki 2014 ka wā a'u i 'ūniki ai ma ke 'ano he kumu hula. Ma kekahi makahiki aku, puka akula au mai Ka Haka 'Ula me ka'u kēkelē laepua 'ōlelo Hawai'i. Ua kula 'ia wau no 15 makahiki a pae i kēia wā puka. Ma hope iho, eia ho'i wau ke kākau aku nei i loko o Ka Lama, 'oiai he kumu nō wau ma Ka 'Umeke Kā'eo. No'u iho nō, 'a'ole wau e ho'ololi i ke ke'ehina o ko'u ola. I loko nō o ka hele loa, kāmoe i ka pahuhopu a mole, a a'a a kāu kūlana.

Ke Kuahaua Kū'ē a ka Mō'i wahine!

"Ku'u 'āina hānau ē, nou au e mele nei."

'O ka Po'alua, lā 17 o Ianuali. M. H. 1893, me he lā e kaulana ana me ka mau loa i loko o ko kākou 'āina hānau nei, no ka mea, 'o ka lā ia i kūkala 'ia mai ai he kūlana Aupuni hou ma lalo o kekahi po'e haole he 'umikūmāmakolu ko lākou nui, ma ke 'ano he aupuni kūikawā no ka manawa.

I ka pō Po'akahi, 'o ia ka ho'omaka 'ia 'ana e kū kia'i 'ia kekahi mau wahi lehulehu o ke kūlanakauhale nei e nā koa o ka manuwā 'Amelika Bosetona me ko lākou pono kaua, a i ke kakahiaka Po'alua a'e ua 'ike 'ia akula lākou e ka'ahele ana, a ua ho'omaka ho'i nā hoa o ka pū'alikoa laipela e hui pū a e pō'ai i kekahi mau wahi me kā lākou mau mea kaua, a ua 'e'ehia ka nānaina o ke kūlanakauhale.

I ke kakahiaka nui, ua laulaha a'ela nā lono lauāhea ma nā pīpā alanui o ke kūlanakauhale nei e kalahea ana, eia ke 'upu 'ia nei e ho'okahuli i ka noho ali'i a e kūkulu a'e i aupuni hou. Ua lele akula kēia lono ma nā welelau makani a hō'ea i nā kua'āina, a ma muli o ia kumu, ua huliā mahi maila nā maka'āinana o ke Ali'i 'ai moku a piha pū nā alanui, a'o ka 'oi loa aku ma nā pō'ai ma waho a ma loko o ka pā Ali'i, a ma waho pono'i iho o Kalākaua Hale he mau kaukani nā kānaka e kū ana a e kali ana me ka mākaukau no nā kauoha, inā he mau kauoha kekahi.

Ua ho'ohanohano nā haumāna iā Lili'uokalani ma ka hana 'ana i pine 'ōmou kalaunu me Kumu Ili ma ka papa pāheona. Ua kilo aku nā haumāna i nā pua kalaunu a Kumu Ili i lawe mai ai. Ua kālailai lākou i kā lākou i kilo ai, ma hope mai ua ho'omaka nā haumāna i ke kala 'ana i kā lākou ki'i. Na Hulali Pu'u'ohau-Cabinilla he haumāna papa 11 ka mea kahaki'i.



Ua koho nā haumāna i ka pua kalaunu a lākou i makemake ai a na Kumu Ili i lamineka a ho'opa'a i pine i lilo ia i pine 'ōmou kalaunu. Ua kaulana 'o Lili'uokalani i kāna pine 'ōmou pulelehua. Wahi a nā limahana ma ka hale ali'i 'o 'Iolani, nenene nā 'ēheu o kāna pine 'ōmou pulelehua.
