
Nā Mea Noho 'Āina Ho'opulapula Mua o Keaukaha

Aia ma lalo iho nei nā inoa o nā mea noho 'āina ho'opulapula mua loa ma ke Kūhiō Settlement. Ma ka lā 16 o Kekemapa makahiki 1924 ua hā'awi 'ia he wahi māhele 'āina i kēia mau Hawai'i. Na kēia mau po'e i kūkulu i nā hale a mahi i ka 'āina. Ua lilo kēia 'āina ka'o i kaiāulu uluwehiwehi.

'O ke Kūhiō Settlement ka 'āina ho'opulapula 'elua ma hope mai 'o Kalama'ula Moloka'i. 'Oiai ua holo pono ka nohona 'āina ho'opulapula ma Keaukaha he hō'opia'i'o kēlā i ka 'Aha'ōlelo e ho'omau aku lākou i ka ho'olako 'ana i nā Hawai'i i māhele 'āina.

He wahi leo mahalo kēia i nā moho o Ka 'Umeke Kā'eo a me nā lālā 'ohana i hō'ea mai e ho'olaule'a i ka piha 'ana he ho'okahi haneli makahiki i ka 'āina ho'opulapula o Keaukaha. Ua nani maoli nō!

E like ho'i me nā mea noho 'āina ho'opulapula mua loa o Keaukaha ua koi 'ia lākou e mahi'ai, he ala ia e hānai ai iā lākou iho, ko lākou 'ohana a me ke kaiāulu ho'i. I kēia mau lā kāka'ikahi ka nui po'e mahi'ai. Hele koke kākou i KTA a ua lako ho'i ka 'ai. Ua a'o 'o Kumu Miki'ala i nā haumāna papa 1 no ka waiwai o nā meakanu a no ke kāmāhuaola a me ka waiwai o ka mahi'ai 'ana. Ua ho'omākaukau 'o ia i nā lako e pono ai lākou no ke kanu 'ana.



Ua kanu ka papa 1 i nā 'ano'ano o ka 'ōhi'a lomi, lekuke, ka lau'ala kilano a me ka lau'ala basil. Pono ka wai, ka lā, nā māhuaola a me ke ea i ulu maika'i ai ka meakanu. E like ho'i me ke kānaka pono ka wai, ka 'ai, ke ea a pēlā aku i ola pono 'o ia. Inā nele paha kekahi o ia mau mea e pilikia ana ke ola. 


I kēia manawa ma ka papa, ke a'o nei mākou no ke kā 'ana i kekahi pūlima a i 'ole he pu'umana hou ma ka 'upena, i lō'ihi mai kona nui a i mohala kūpono ke ho'oku'u 'ia. Ua ho'omaka mākou mai ka piko mai a pāku'i he 36 maka. Ho'omau 'ia kēia kā 'ana me ke a'a pu'upu'u no 5 lālani a laila pūlima a pu'mana 'ia kekahi maka hou aku.

Ho'opili mākou i ke kā 'upena 'ana me ka papa makemakika me Kumu Emilia Kaawa ma o ka 'āwili 'ana i ke ana honua, nā kinona komolike, nā ana huina, nā lauana, a me nā ha'ihehu.

Ma ka Papa 9, ua ho'omaka mākou i papahana 'imi noi'i no nā wahi o Keaukaha mai ka Palekai a i Leleiwi. Ua ho'ohui 'ia ka Papa 9 a me ka Papa 10 a ho'omāhelehele 'ia mākou ma nā hui.
