Ke Aloha 'Āina;

He aha ia?

'O ke Aloha 'Āina, 'o ia ka 'Ume Mākēneki i loko o ka pu'uwal i ka Lāhui, e kāohi ana i ka noho Kū'oko'a Lanakila 'ana o kona one hānau ponoī.

'O ka 'Ume Mākēneki, 'o ia nō ka ikaika nāna i kāohi i ke kui mākēneki o ke Pānānā, e ho'opolelei ana i kona kuhikuhi i ka welelau 'Ākau o ka Honua nei, a i ka hōkū 'ākau ho'i.

He mea pohihih i ka 'ike 'ana i kahi i loa'a ai ia mea he 'ume i loko o ka hao mākēneki, akā, eia ka mea maopopo loa, aia kēlā kui mākēneki ke ho'omau lā i kona kuhikuhi 'ana i ka hōkū 'ākau ma ka wēlau 'ākau o ka honua nei.

Pēlā ke aloha i loko o ka pu'uwal i ke kanaka no kona 'āina hānau ponoī. 'A'ole i 'ike maka 'ia ia mea he aloha, 'a'ole ho'i hiki ke ho'opa'a 'ia, 'a'ole ho'i e hiki ke hāhā 'ia; akā, ua laha wale aku 'o ia, a ua lele wale aku a pili i kona 'āina hānau ponoī iho, me he 'ume lā o ke kui mākēneki.

Inā i ho'okokoke 'ia nā kui hao mākēneki i kahi ho'okahi, a laila, he mea maopopo loa me ke kānalua 'ole o ka mana'o, ua 'ume like nō lākou a pau loa kekah i kekah i.

Pēlā ho'i nā lāhui a me nā kānaka a pau loa i noho piha 'ia e ka 'uhane aloha i ka 'āina hānau. E 'ike auane'i ko lākou huki 'ana, 'ume 'ana, a me ko lākou kāohi 'ana i ka noho Kū'oko'a Lanakila 'ana o ko lākou 'āina hānau.

Mai ka pūnāwai o Palahemo a i Puna paia 'ala i ka hala a i ke one 'ā o Leleiwi. Aloha mai kākou e ka 'ohana Ka 'Umeke Kā'eo.

'O Frank Baptiste ke kāne a 'o Marie Kealoha ka wahine, noho pū lāua a hānau 'ia 'o Franklin Baptiste, he kāne. 'O ke kāne he kāne a 'o Jeanie Enaena-laea ka wahine, noho pū lāua a hānau 'ia 'o Doreen Kaleiwahea, he wahine. 'O Franklin Baptiste ke kane a 'o Doreen Kaleiwahea ka wahine, noho pū lāua a hānau 'ia 'o Kainoa Baptiste, he wahine. 'O wau nō 'o Kumu Kainoa Baptiste. Ua hānau 'ia au ma O'ahu a hānai 'ia au ma kahi o Mt. View.

Ua hele au i ke kula ha'aha'a 'o Keaukaha. Ma ia wā ua launa au me nā haumāna kaiapuni i laila a ua nui ko'u hoihoi e a'o i ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i. Ma ia wā ua launa pū au me kekahī kumu kāko'o a 'o kona inoa 'o Kanani Kamahele. Ma kona a'o 'ana ia'u i nā oli a me na mele, ua ulu nō ko'u 'i'ini e a'o i ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i. Akā na'e, 'a'ole i hiki ia'u ke komo i ke kula kaiapuni a 'a'ole i pa'a ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i i ko'u mau mākua. No laila, ua ho'omau au i ka hele kula i Waiākea. Ma ko'u wā hele kula ki'eki'e ua komo au i nā papa 'ōlelo Hawai'i a ho'oholo au e hele ma ia ala 'imi na'auao ma ko'u hele 'ana i ke kula nui ma Hilo. Ua 'ike nō au ia'u ma ka papa 6, e lilo au i Kumu 'ōlelo Hawai'i ma ke kula kaiapuni.

Eia nō au, he lālā o Ka 'Umeke nei. Mai ko'u wā papa 6, ua nui ko'u makemake e a'o ma Ke Kula Kaiapuni 'o Keaukaha. 'O ia ka inoa o ke kula kaiapuni ma ko'u wā kamali'i. Ua nui ko'u hana e 'imi i ala no ka ho'okō 'ana i ka palapala kekelē a me ka laikini a'o ma ke kula nui akā 'a'ole nō i hā'awipio. Ma hope o ko'u puka kula nui 'ana, 'a'ohē kūlana hana ma Keaukaha nei no laila ua a'o au ma Ke Kula Kaiapuni 'o Waimea. Ua kalaiwa nō i nā lā a pau i Waimea a hana i laila no 4 makahiki. Mau nō ka hā'awipio 'ole 'ana. Ma ka makahiki 2010, ua hai 'ia au ma Ka 'Umeke nei. Nui ko'u hau'oli a ha'aheo ma ke 'ano he lālā Ka 'Umeke.

Ha'aheo nō au i ko'u lāhui a me ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i. 'A'ole ka 'ōlelo he hana. He kuleana a he nohona ho'i. Penei au e a'o ai i ka'u mau keiki a ho'okahua a pa'a lākou ma kēia 'ano nohona Hawai'i. Ma ke 'ano he keiki, 'ike nō au i ka nele o ka 'i'ini e mālama i ka 'ōlelo. Akā na'e, me ka'u mau keiki pono'i, 'o ka hiapo 'o La'akea a 'o ka'u kaikamahine 'o Pūlama, ma ko lāua ulu 'ana a'e , ma ia wā nō i 'ike ai i ka waiwai o ka 'ōlelo makuahine. Paipai nō au i ka'u muli 'o Kaiao e kūpa'a ma ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i. A 'o kēia ka leo paipai iā kākou a pau e ka 'ohana Ka 'Umeke, e kūpa'a a mālama kākou i kēia hō'ola 'ōlelo. Penei kākou e hō'ola ai i ko kākou lāhui. *E ola ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i!*

## No ka Paipai I'a

Ua 'ākoakoa nā po'o, nā kumu, nā limahana, nā haumāna, nā 'ohana a me ka po'e o ke kaiāulu no ka paipai i'a 'ana ma Waiuli. Ua paipai 'ia ka i'a e 'au i ka 'upena, ua wa'u 'ia nā niu, ua kāwī 'ia nā hua'ai, ua poke 'ia ke 'ulu, ua ho'opē 'ia nā uala a ua unaunahi 'ia ka i'a.

Nui ka hana ma ia lā eia nō na'e ua kō piha nā kuleana a ua alu like mai ka po'e. 'O ka holoholo pa'ipa'i he hana a ko kākou kūpuna. Ku'u 'ia ka 'upena a mai kekahi 'ao'ao pa'ipa'i 'ia ka 'ili o ke kai i mea e ho'ohuikau a ho'omaka'u ai i nā i'a me ka paipai pū e 'au i ka 'upena a hei akula. Ua nui nā po'e ma kai e kōkua ana me kēia hana 'o ka holoholo pa'ipa'i. Hele a piula koke nā kānaka i ka hana nui o ka holoholo pa'ipa'i. 'O kekahi kauno'o ke kauno'o kuke. Ua lele koke 'o 'Anakē Kamala i ke alaka'i 'ana i ka po'e - he pokepoke uala, he wa'u niu, he 'oki'oki hua'ai me ka lau'ai a he kāwī hua'ai i mea inu i ia ahiahi.

No ka nui o nā lima kōkua ma ke kauno'o kuke, ua ho'omākaukau 'ia nā 'ano 'ai like 'ole. 'O ke curry moa 'oe, 'o ka lumpia kō'elepālau 'oe, 'o ka i'a palai 'oe, 'o ka sāleta hua'ai pāhale 'oe, 'o ke kupa i'a me ka pala'ai 'oe, 'o ka wai hua'ai keu a ka 'ono 'oe a 'o nā 'ano limu like 'ole 'oe, a nui hou aku ka 'ai e ho'opiha ai i ko wahi 'ōpū. Ua nani maoli nō ka 'ike i nā 'ohana e launa pū ana. Penei e pili ai ko kākou 'ohana kula. Inā 'a'ole i hiki iā 'oe ke hui ma ia Halewalea, lana ka mana'o e hiki ana iā 'oe a me ka 'ohana ke hō'ea ma nā Halewalea e koe nei.



## No Ka Hana Imu

Ua hui kekahi o nā kumu, nā limahana, nā haumāna, nā 'ohana a me nā lālā o ke kaiaulu i Kaumaui no ka hana imu 'ana. Ua kālua 'ia ka pua'a, ka pelehū, ka moa, ka 'ulu, ke kalo ame ka 'uala. 'A'ohē o mākou maka'u i ka hana! Ua lele koke a alu like ma ka hana i kō piha a i kō koke.

'Akahi, ho'oma'ema'e 'ia nā lau niu a me nā lā'i. 'Alua, ulana 'ia nā 'ie niu kahi e kau ai i ka 'ai. 'Akolu, hehe'e ka 'i'o a kāpī 'ia i ka pa'akai i li'u maika'i, a wahī piha 'ia i nā lā'i a me ka lau niu.

I ia 'aunalā nō, ua mākaukau ka imu ua 'ā akula. 'Ekolu a 'ehā paha hola ka lō'ihi o ka ho'owela 'ana i nā pōhaku a 'ena'ena kūpono. Ma ia wā kīhaehae maika'i 'ia ka pūmai'a i mākaukau no ka imu. Ho'ohana 'ia ka pūmai'a no ka mālama 'ana i ka nui wai i loko o ka imu. I ka hui 'ana o ka wela o nā pōhaku me ka wai o nā lau, pua a'e ka māhu a pēlā e kālua 'ia ai nā 'ai.

Ho'opāki'i 'ia nā pōhaku i ia manawa, laulima mākou i ke kau 'ana i nā lau mai'a a me ka pūmai'a ma luna o nā 'eho. Ua ki'i koke 'ia ka 'ai a waiho akula ma luna o ka pūmai'a. Uhi 'ia ka 'ai me ka lau mai'a hou aku a me ka lā'i. Ua kau mākou i kapolena a ma luna o kēlā ka lepo i mālama maika'i 'ia ka wela o ka imu.

## *Ke Kau Makahiki*

Me ka ‘ūpoho ‘ūpoho pa‘i i mālama ‘ia ai ka pana a helu ‘ia nā ‘ai a Lono. Ma kēlā me kēia hea ‘ana, ka‘i akula kekahi ‘elele papa e hā‘awi aku ai i kā lākou ho‘okupu. Ua ka‘i ka ‘aha a ua noa nā pā‘ani makahiki.

‘O ka ‘ulu maika ‘oe, ‘o ka moa pahe‘e ‘oe, ‘o ka hukihuki ‘oe, ‘o ke kūkini ‘oe a nui hou aku nā pā‘ani i pā‘ani ‘ia. Ua ‘ākoakoa ko Ka ‘Umeke Kā‘eo, Ke Ana La‘ahana a me ko Hi‘ikeakaikamālama ma ka pā mau‘u o Pā Hoaka. ‘Ike a lohe koke ‘ia ka ho‘olaule‘a ‘ana i ia wā. He leo mahalo kēia iā Hui Ho‘oleimaluō i ke kāko‘o mau ma ka ho‘omākaukau ‘ana i ka ‘ai me ka hānai pū iā mākou a me ke kaiaulu. Mahalo pū i nā ‘ohana i ka hō‘ihī i kā mākou ‘aha no Lono.





## Ka'ae'a

Ho'olaule'a kākou i ka lā 28 o Nowemapa 'oiai ua pūlima kūhelu 'ia ke kūkala Anglo-Franco i ia lā 180 makahiki aku nei. Ua ho'olaule'a 'ia ka lā Kū'oko'a no 5 kekeke ma ka heihei holo lio, ha'i'ōlelo, mele, 'aha 'aina a me nā paikau. Pēlā nō ka hana a i ka ho'okahuli 'ia o ke aupuni Hawai'i. Na ke aupuni hou i kāohi i ka mālama kūmau i ia lā nui ma Hawai'i.


