


Aha Mele Ho'oilo

Ua nanea maoli ka pepeiao i ka lohe 'ana i nā leo nahenahe o nā haumāna. I kēia makahiki ua keu ho'i ka u'i o ka hale ha'uki. Mahalo i ke kōmike 'Aha Mele Ho'oilo i ka ho'olauka'i, ka ho'onaninani a me ka ho'oma'ema'e 'ana i ka hale ha'uki ma ia pō le'ale'a nō.



Lā Mō'aukala

I nā lā 16-17 o lanuali nei i hō'ike ai nā haumāna papa 7-11 i kā lākou mau pāhana mō'aukala. 'O ka mākia o ia mau pāhana i kēia makahiki: "Nā Pono me Nā Kuleana ma ka Mō'aukala". Ua noi'i nā haumāna no kekahī mahina a laila ua kūkulu pāhana lākou no kekahī mahina. Ua maika'i loa kekahī po'e haumāna ma ka 'imi 'ana i nā kūmole kuamua ma o ka 'ohi 'ana i nā ki'i a me ka nīnauele 'ana i nā loea. Na ka haumāna i koho i kāna kumuhanā noi'i ma ka mō'aukala a me ke 'ano o kāna pāhana e kāpili ai: he pepa, he papa hō'ike'ike, he kī'i'oni'oni, he kahuapa'a pūnaewe, a i 'ole he hana keaka. 'O kekahī o nā haumāna ua noi'i no ke kuleana 'āina o ka po'e Hawai'i, no ka wai o Waiāhole, no nā pono sivila o nā wāhine, no ka mo'omeheu me ka hula, no ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i, no ke kapu o Ni'ihiwai a no nā kumuhanā hoihoi 'ē a'e he nui. Koho 'ia nā pāhana 'oi kelakela o ke kula e holo mua no Ka 'Umeke Kā'eo ma ka ho'okūkū District History Day me nā kula 'ē a'e o ka mokupuni ma ka lā 22 o Pepeluali. Mai ia fea kālana, wae hou 'ia nā pāhana 'oi loa e holomua no ka ho'okūkū moku'āina ma O'ahu, State History Day, ma ka lā 5 o 'Apelila ma ke Kula Kaiāulu 'o Windward. 'Ie holo ē.



'Aha Hui Haumāna

Aloha kāua e ka mea heluhelu! Eia au ke ho'olaha aku nei i ka holomua o ka 'Aha Hui Haumāna i nā mahina i hala aku nei. 'O ka hana nui a nā 'ēlele kula waena, 'o ia ka 'imi 'ana i mau hana ho'oulu kālā i mea e lako ai ka hulahula kula waena i ho'opane'e 'ia a i Pepeluali. Ke hana pūalu nei lākou ma ka 'oka 'ana i nā wehi ho'onaninani, ka ho'oholo 'ana i ka mea'ai, ke kū'ai 'ana aku i nā kikiki, a pēlā wale aku. He mākau kūpono ka ho'olālā 'ana e a'o ai nā haumāna kula waena i mea e mākaukau ai no ka wā kula kī'eki'e a me ka wā kanaka makua.

'O ka hana a nā haumāna kula kī'eki'e, 'o ia ka ho'olālā 'ana i ka hulahula Prom! Nui ka hana ma ke noi kālā, ka 'imi kālā, a me ka ho'olālā 'ana i nā lāli'i no ia pō hulahula. He kāko'o a he alaka'i pū nā haumāna kula kī'eki'e na nā haumāna kula waena ma ka ho'olālā 'ana.

'O kekahī hana a nā 'ēlele e ho'omaka ana, 'o ia ka ho'omākaukau 'ana i nā wikiō a me nā hō'ailona paha e ho'ohanohano ai i ka Mahina 'Ōlelo Hawai'i ma Pepeluali. He wā kēia e ho'olaule'a pū ai kākou i ka 'ōlelo makuahine ma nā wahi a pau o ke ola! 'O ke kuleana o ka 'ēlele ka paipai me ka ho'oholomua 'ana i nā haumāna. 'O ka paipai 'ana i ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i kekahī ala e ho'olōkahi ai i nā haumāna a pau ma ka mana'o like i ho'okā'oi mau ke kula!

I ke kau mua o kēia makahiki kula, ua komo ka papa 9-10 i ka papa mākau kino. He 'ālapakonakolu ka hō'ike hope loa o ia papa. Ma ka pule ma hope pono o ka Malakona Honolulu a Kumu Hau'oli i holo ai, ma ka lā 12 o Kekemapa, ua 'au nā haumāna ma Reed's Bay he 500 mika, ua holo a puni Banyan Drive he 2 kilomika, a ua holo paikikala ma Crossfit Huaka'i he 5,000 kilomika. He kilihune ma mua o ka ho'omaka 'ana, malino ke kai ma ka 'au 'ana, 'ōmalumalu ma ka wā holo, a laila, ua pā 'olu'olu mai ka lā ma ka pau 'ana o ka hanana. Mahalo nui iā Kapua Sawyer me Israel Gonsalves o Crossfit Huaka'i no ka mālama 'ana i nā haumāna o Ka 'Umeke Kā'eo. Mahalo ho'i i nā makua i hō'ea ma ia lā e kū ka'awale ma ke ala no ka palekana o ko kākou mau 'ālapa: 'O Ku'ulei Kanahele, Lehua Miller, U'ilani Evans, Ka'ainoa 'Ena'ena, me Aster Dolor. He ho'omaika'i nui kēia i ka papa 9-10 no ka hana maika'i ma ka 'ālapakonakolu a no ke kūpa'a mau ma ia papa mākau kino. E ho'omau i ka ho'oikaika kino; he nohona kanaka e ola loa ai kākou, e hā'ehuola ka lāhui.

Ua mālama akula ku'u 'ohana i ka lā kuni pipi ma ko mākou 'āina hānai pipi, 'o ia ho'i 'o Nobriga Ranch, i kapa mua 'ia nō ho'i i ka wā i hala, 'o Pu'u 'Ō'ō Ranch. 'O kēia 'āina 'o Pu'u 'Ō'ō, aia nō ke waiho akula i ka uka loa o Pi'ilhonua e pili pū ana me Humu'ula. Ma mua o ka lilo 'ana o ka ho'olimalima 'ia o ua Pu'u 'Ō'ō nei i ka 'ohana, ua ho'olimalima mua 'ia e ka 'ohana Kipimana. A ma mua ho'i o ua 'ohana Kipimana nei a i loko o ka wā o ke aupuni mō'i, na John T. Baker i ho'olimalima i ia 'āina a me ke ahupua'a holo'oko'a o Pi'ilhonua.

I kēia mau lā, na ka 'ohana Nobriga e ho'olimalima nei i ia 'āina e hānai ai i ka pipi. He lālā au no ka 'ohana Nobriga a ua makemake au e ho'ohanohano iā lākou ma ka haku 'ana i mele no ko'u mau 'anakala, nā po'o ho'i o Nobriga Ranch. Pili kēia mele i ka lā kuni pipi i mālama 'ia ma ka lā 28 o Kekemapa 2024. Ma ia lā, ua hui akula nā 'ohana paniolo like 'ole o Hawai'i Nui Kuauli e kōkua a kāko'o i ke kuni 'ana i nā pipi keiki. He mea ma'a mau nō kēia hana a puni nā 'āina hānai pipi o Hawai'i, a puni ho'i ka honua nei.

No laila, i ke kakahiaka 'ana a'e, ua mākaukau ihola mākou ka 'ohana no ka pi'i 'ana me ke 'alo pū 'ana i ke anu a me ke ko'eko'e. Pi'i akula nō nā kalaka a komo i loko o nā puka pā he nui wale. 'O ke kumu o kēia mau puka pā he nui wale, makemake nō e hō'opia i ka mālama 'ia o nā pipi ma kahi kūpono, 'a'ole e 'auana wale aku a nalowale.
